Rules of Thirds, Simplicity, Framing, Leading Lines, Symmetry

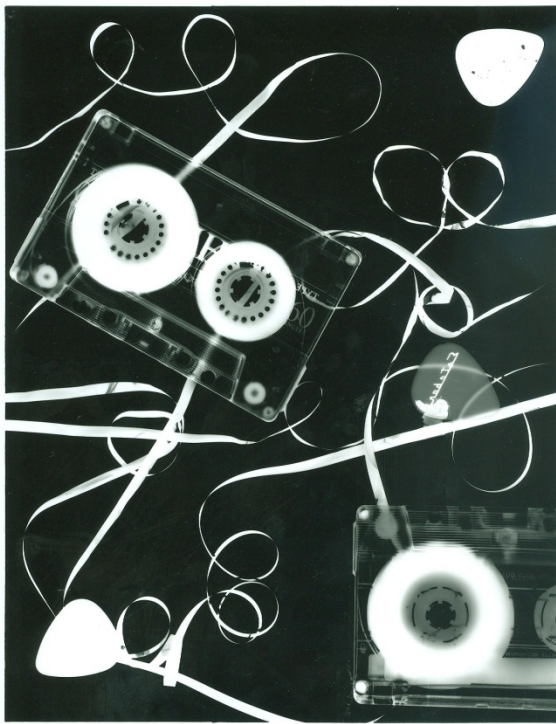
